- Course Structure: Theory and practical classes.



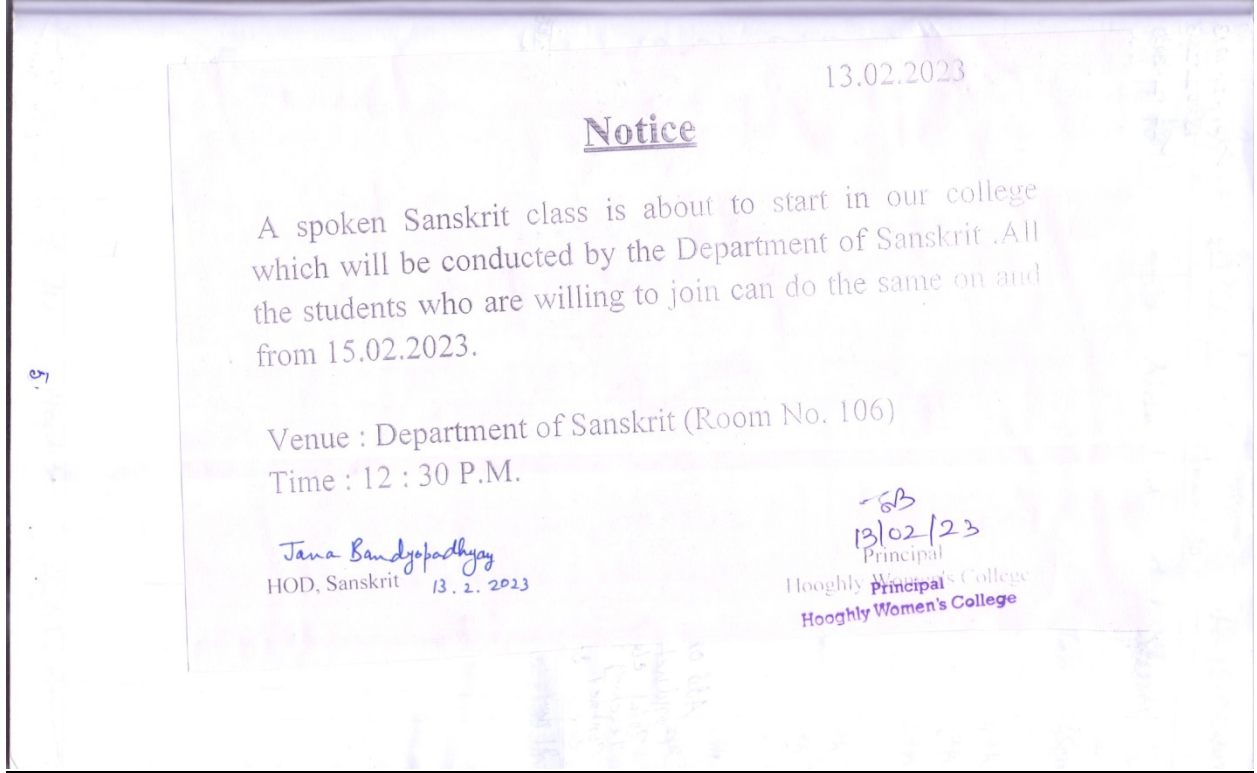
